Special race's rules

Art 1 - Organization

The amateur sport association Ciclo Abilia in cooperation with A.S.D.A.Fa.P.H. organize on April 8 2017 in Massa (MS) the second edition of "DUE GIORNI DEL MARE", international race for disabled people, reserved to handbike, tricycle, cycling and tandem categories.

Art 2 - Participation

The race is open to all athletes of both sexes, with known medical suitability and FCI license or National Cycling Federation license belonging to UCI.

Art 3 - Special Provisions

It is compulsory to wear the rigid helmet. Participants assume all responsibility for the risks arising from participation in the event: falls, contacts with other participants, vehicles, audience and etc, the organizing committee and its representatives will not be responsible for them. For not covered rules on this regulation, it will follow the international UCI and the national FCI regulation.

Art 4 - Inscriptions

For Italian athletes, the inscriptions are exclusively received through the FCI system (factor K), ID of the race 128237, pointing out in the marks the participation to the time trial race, road race or both. The foreign athletes have to enroll by email address segreteria@montignosociociclismo.it or by fax number 00390585.624907.

The registrations will close on April 02, 2017 at 24.00.

The athletes declare with registration to be physically fit to participate in the race scheduled.

The organizing committee reserves the right to refuse unwanted entries.

Art 6 - Handbike Equipment

For security reason of the athletes participating in the competition, it is required the use of the back bar in addition to the double brake.

The absence of such technical requirements will result the exclusion of the athlete to the race.

Art 7 - Race Course and Departure Operations

The race course is completely flat of 9 km developed on the waterfront of Massa, as per the enclosed map.
